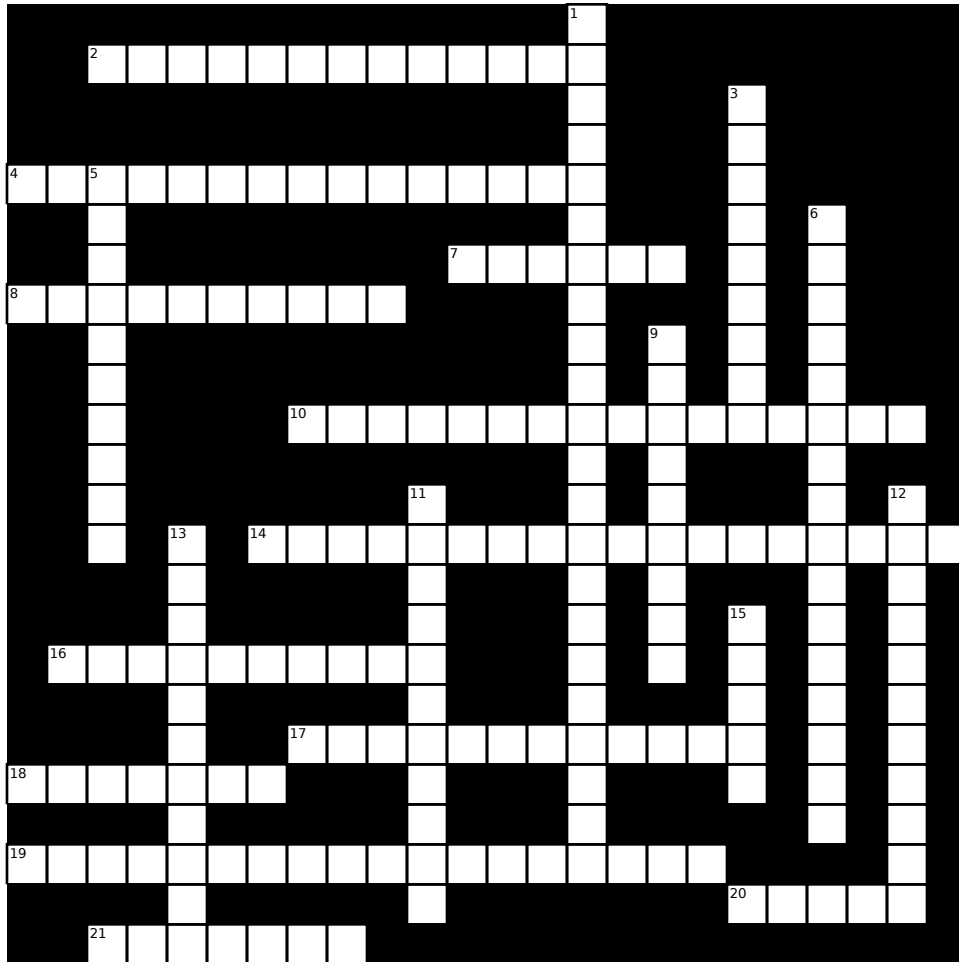


# Civil Rights Movement
