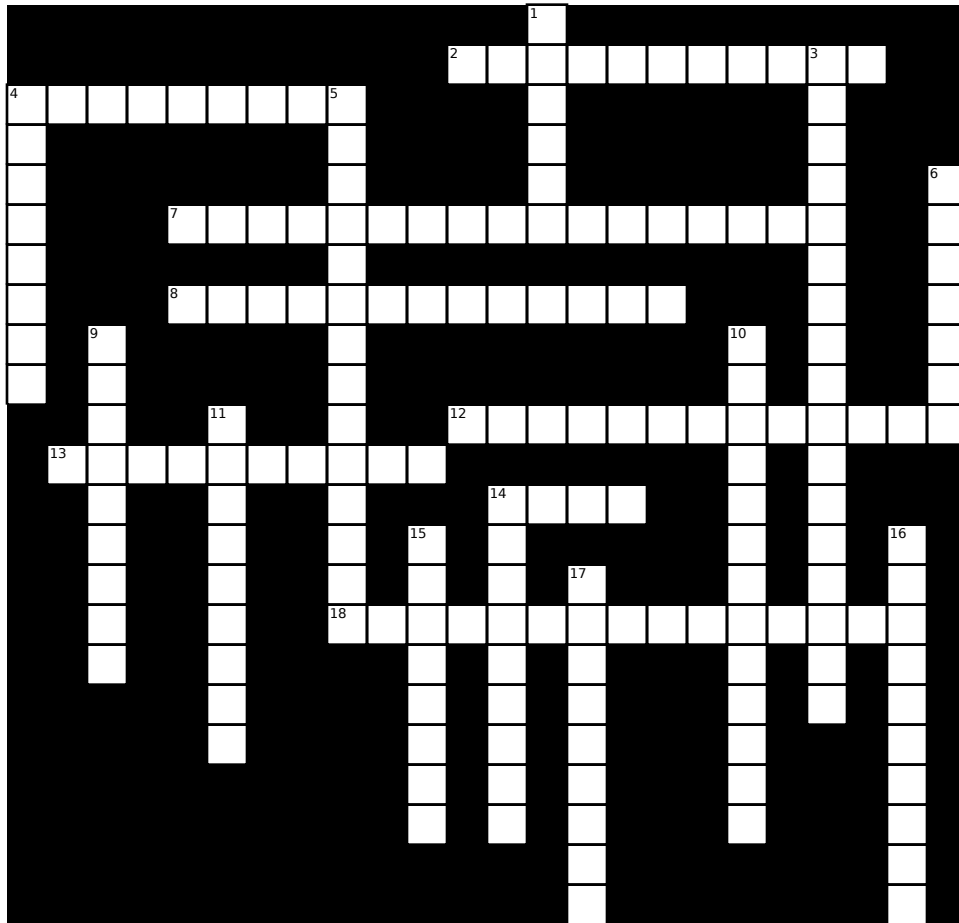


# Holocaust

- 2 This legislation passed by the Germany government that ended the parliamentary democracy and allowed Hitler to enact and enforce laws.
- 4 A place of worship for the Jewish faith.
- 7 The meeting of representatives from various departments of the Nazi government to coordinate the Final Solution.
- 8 The event when Germans were encouraged to commit violent acts against Jews in which hundreds of synagogues were burned, thousands of Jewish businesses were looted, and tens of thousands of Jews were arrested.
- 12 Arrange or direct the elements of a situation to produce a desired effect.
- 13 President of Germany who appointed Hitler.
- 14 A sudden, violent, and illegal seizure of power from a government.
- 18 The court proceedings that sought to punish those who participated in the atrocities of the Holocaust.
