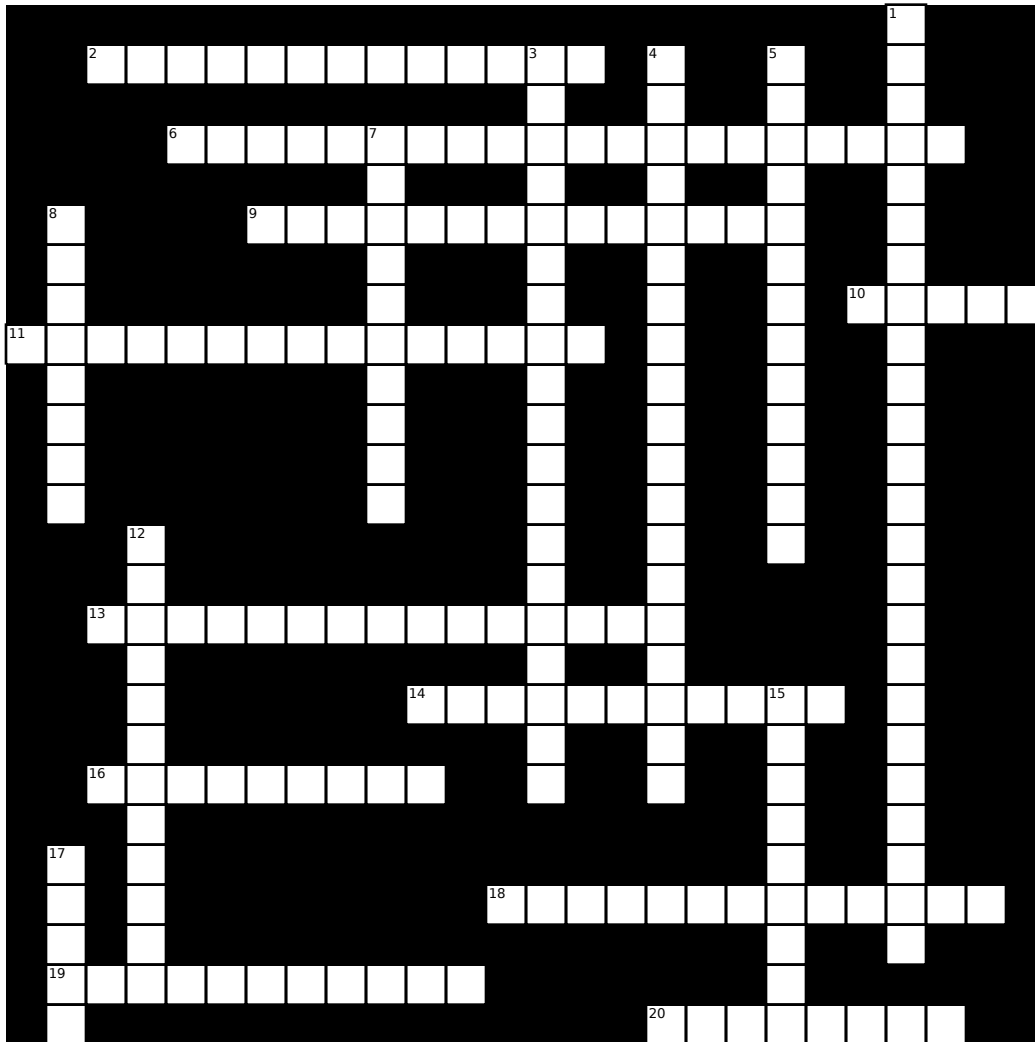


# Industrial Revolution
