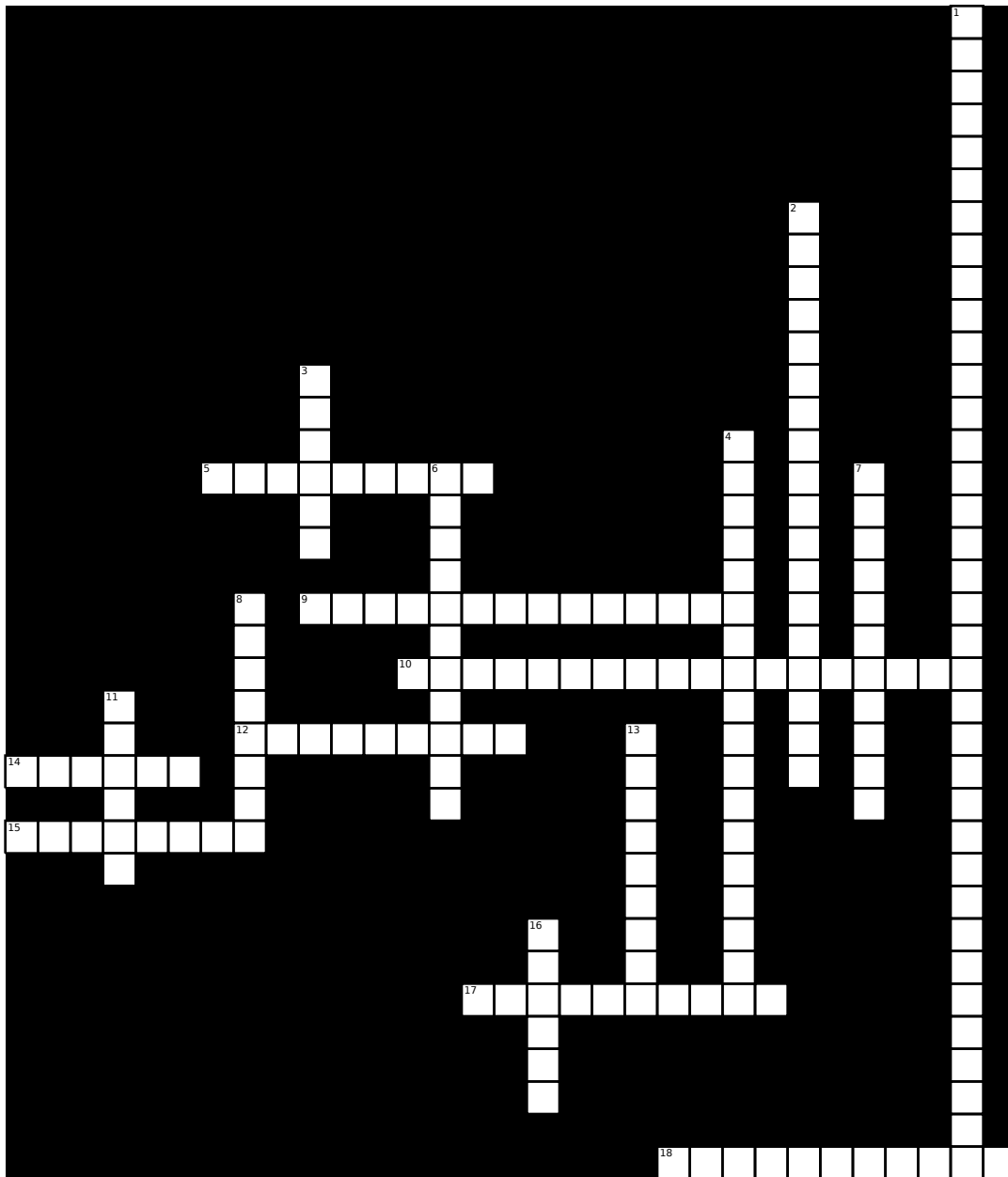


# World War One

- 5 Russian political party led by Lenin that staged a communist revolution in Russia and wanted an end to Russian involvement in WWI.
- 9 This is where the Archduke Ferdinand and his wife were from, whose assassination started WWI.
- 10 The African American military unit that was part of the American Expeditionary Force in France.
- 12 An agreement to stop fighting long enough for leaders to try to negotiate a peace agreement.
- 14 The country east of Germany that was formed out of the German empire after the signing of the Treaty of Versailles.
- 15 The shutting of a port to prevent people or supplies from going in or out.
- 17 The policy of building up a country's military.
- 18 Excessive pride in one's nation.

- 1 The four countries (in alphabetical order) that made up the Allied Powers during WWI.
- 2 Intercepted communication that tried to establish an alliance between Germany and Mexico.
- 3 This country declared war on Austria-Hungary after war was declared on Serbia.
- 4 Formally ended WWI and placed most of the blame on Germany.
- 6 The policy of a powerful country seeking to control the political and economic affairs of a weaker country.
- 7 Cash payments made for a some wrongdoing. As it pertains to WWI, these were supposed to be made by Germany to the victorious nations for losses suffered during the war.
- 8 An agreement between countries for mutual protection or other benefits.
- 11 The biggest country that borders Germany to the west.
- 13 British passenger liner destroyed by a German submarine, which killed 1,200 people including 128 Americans.
- 16 President of the United States during WWI.
